- ◆ With your uniform, you will receive a patch that is to be sewn on the left sleeve of the baseball shirt
- ◆ How to help your team? Every team needs help from families to have a successful season. Some ways that you can serve are: dug out duty, score-keeper, team-mom, fundraiser mom, or assist coach at practices.
- ◆ Also, everyone can provide water cooler and cups for games and practices, practice at home
